“Library Research, Support and Services for MIE Graduate Students”

The library seminar caters to graduate students in the disciplines of Mechanical Engineering and Industrial Engineering. This initiative is intended to promote library resources and services. Seminar attendees will be introduced to research materials including databases features and functionalities that enable scholarly research efficiencies in literature reviews and research profiling. Searching the web efficiently and important criteria for evaluating web resources will be discussed in terms of lifelong learning skills. Students will also be introduced to the basics of the time-saving bibliographic management program **EndNote** as well as the MSWORD “*cite while you write*” feature.

Haymwantee P. Singh is a Technical Reference Librarian at NJIT's R.W. Van Houten Library, a position she has held since September 1992. She serves as the library's liaison to the departments of Mechanical and Industrial Engineering, Electrical and Computer Engineering, Engineering Technology, Distance Learning.
